EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 09 Series of 2024

AN ORDER DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF PANABO

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life, health, safety and property and to promote the general welfare of its people at all times, especially during disasters and calamities:

WHEREAS, due to the Tough of Low Pressure Area (LPA), the Honorable Governor Edwin I. Jubahib issued a Memorandum dated January 31, 2024, ordering the suspension of face-to-face classes in all public and private schools of this province;

WHEREAS, in accordance with its commitment to protect the lives of its residents, the City Government of Panabo has always prioritized the safety of every individual in the City;

WHEREAS, under Chapter III, Section 455 of the Local Government Code, provides the power of the Local Chief Executive to carry out such measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, City Mayor of Panabo, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES. To ensure the well-being of students in the City of Panabo and as a proactive and preventative measure against any adverse events that may arise from the persistent rainfall caused by the Trough of LPA, classes at all levels in private and public schools shall be suspended today, January 31, 2024, until lifted.

SECTION 2. WEATHER MONITORING. The CDRRMO is tasked to keep track of the weather updates and advisories from PAGASA and report to the undersigned on its developments and/or subsequent action.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
