



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12
Series of 2024

AN ORDER LIFTING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND SUSPENSION OF WORK IN PUBLIC OFFICES IN THE CITY OF PANABO AS DECLARED UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 09 AND 10, SERIES OF 2024

WHEREAS, the Province of Davao del Norte was among the provinces in the Davao Region affected by the Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA), which caused widespread flooding and landslides within the province;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2024, upon the order of the Hon. Governor Edwin I. Jubahib, Executive Order Nos. 09 and 10, Series of 2024 were issued declaring the suspension of classes at all levels in private and public schools, as well as the suspension of work in public offices in the City of Panabo;

WHEREAS, given the improved weather conditions, the Hon. Governor issued a memorandum lifting the suspension of classes and work in the Province of Davao del Norte;


NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, City Mayor of Panabo, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. LIFTING THE DECLARATION OF THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AND WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES. In order to regain the regular activities and operations of all educational institutions and governmental offices, Executive Order Nos. 09 and 10, Series of 2024, are hereby lifted. Classes at all levels in private and public schools, as well as work in government offices in the City of Panabo, are to resume on February 5, 2024.

SECTION 2. WEATHER MONITORING. It shall be the responsibility of the Emergency Operations Center/City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office to monitor the weather update and communicate any developments or immediate required actions to the undersigned.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
