



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 158

**AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR THE
WOMEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS OF THE CITY OF PANABO**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14, Article II, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the state recognizes the role of women in nation-building, and shall ensure the fundamental equality before the law of women and men;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7192, otherwise known as the "*Magna Carta of Women*", was enacted to promote the empowerment of women, ensure equal opportunities for women and men, and ensure equal access to resources and to development results and outcomes;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 224, declares the first week of *March of every year as Women's Week and March 8, 1988 and every year thereafter as Women's Rights and International Peace Day*; and Presidential Proclamation No. 227, provides for the observance of the *Month of March as 'Women's Role in History Month'*;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Republic Act and Proclamations, signed by Corazon C. Aquino, the first female President of the Philippines, recognizes the Filipino women's contribution in the struggle for national independence, civil liberties, equality and human rights and emphasizes the role of Filipino women in the social, cultural, economic and political development throughout our history;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Panabo through the Gender and Development Section, recognizes the full potential of women and their contribution to progress in the community;

WHEREAS, as we celebrate Women's Month in March, the City will also honor and acknowledge the efforts and achievements of empowered women who have led by example and inspired women and everyone in Panabo City;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the Screening Committee for the Women of the Year Awards as created under Executive Order No. 7, Series of 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS**, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION I. REORGANIZATION. The Women of the Year Awards Screening Committee is hereby reorganized and shall be composed of the following:


SECTION II. FUNCTIONS. The Screening Committee shall perform the following functions:

1. Formulate nomination guidelines, categories and criteria for the selection of the Top 10 Women of the Year;
2. Identify ten (10) women who have shown excellence, leadership, influence, or innovation in their respective field of expertise in accordance to Section II, Item 1;
3. Determine the necessary funds to procure prizes, tokens, and other operating expenses relative to the awarding ceremony;
4. Promote success stories of the Top 10 Women of the Year for the public to be aware of and for the women to follow; and
5. Perform other duties and functions as may be prescribed by law.

SECTION III. OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AND FUNDING. All costs pertaining to the operations and activities of the Committee shall be taken from the available funds and resources of the City, all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately after signing hereof.
