EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 183 Series of 2023

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING AN INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM FOR THE ALVEO IRONMAN 70.3 IN PANABO CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Davao is hosting the Alveo Ironman 70.3, an international triathlon sporting event on March 26, 2023, the event is expected to draw thousands of athletes, spectators, and visitors to Metropolitan Davao;

WHEREAS, the City of Panabo is one of the points for the 90 km Bike ride race route from Davao City to Tagum City and vice-versa from 3:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. of March 26, 2023:

WHEREAS, to ensure the safety and security of all participants and attendees, it is necessary to establish an Incident Management Team (IMT) to manage and coordinate emergency response efforts during the event;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, City Mayor of Panabo, do hereby order the establishment of an IMT for Ironman 2023 in Panabo City.

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Incident Management Team (IMT) shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

:

- 1. Develop and implement an incident action plan for the event
- 2. Monitor and evaluate incident response and recovery efforts
- 3. Coordinate with local emergency response agencies, including law enforcement, fire, and medical services
- 4. Provide public information and warnings as necessary
- 5. Manage and allocate resources, including personnel, equipment, and supplies
- 6. Ensure compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, and policies
- 7. Ensure the safety and security of all participants and attendees of the event.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until the conclusion of the Ironman 2023 event.
