EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 200 Series of 2023

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE PANABO CITY PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT TEAM FOR THE SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE FOR BARANGAYS (SGLGB)

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to recognize the good performance of local government units (LGUs) in transparency and accountability in the use of public funds, preparedness for challenges posed by disasters, sensitivity to the needs of vulnerable and marginalized sectors of society, implementation of health programs, investment and employment promotion, protection of constituency from threats to life and damage to property, and safeguarding the integrity of the environment;

WHEREAS, Section 5, Article II of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property and the promotion of general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

WHEREAS, Section 3 (h) and 3 (m), and Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991, provided that there shall be a continuing mechanism to enhance local autonomy not only by legislative enabling acts but also by administrative and organizational reforms, that the national government of the performance of local government units (LGUs) and the quality of community life, that each LGU shall exercise its powers essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 32 of the LGC 1991 asserts the city and municipal supervision over their respective barangays. Through the city or municipal mayor concerned, they shall exercise general supervision over component barangays to ensure that said barangays act within the scope of their prescribed powers and function;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act No. 11292 otherwise known as "The Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019" states the powers and functions of the Council of Good Local Governance (CGLG), which include conducting an evaluation of the performance of LGUs for purposes of determining the need for enhancing or continuing the SGLG in barangays, and recommending any amendatory legislation;

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Rule V of the IRR of the SGLG Act, provides that DILG-BLGS shall oversee the SGLG assessment in the provinces, cities, and municipalities, while the DILG-NBOO shall oversee the assessment in the barangays;

WHEREAS, the SGLG for Barangays (SGLGB) encourages and challenges the barangays to scale up its performance and practices of good governance that accord primacy to the principles of accountability, transparency, performance and effectiveness under the following performance areas:

Three (3) Core areas (needs to pass all three core areas)

- a. Safety, Peace and Order
- b. Financial Administration and Sustainability, and
- c. Disaster Preparedness;

Three (3) Essential Areas (needs to pass atleast one of the three essential areas)

a. Social Protection and Sensitivity

- b. Business-Friendliness and Competitiveness
- c. Environmental Management

WHEREAS, in compliance with the SGLG Act, the City Government of Panabo through the SGLG Committee resolves to organize the Panabo City Performance Assessment Team for SGLGB that shall be responsible to conduct the SGLGB assessment and to ensure the completeness, legitimacy and accuracy of the data submitted;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, City Mayor, by the virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following;

SECTION 1. CREATION OF PANABO CITY PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT TEAM FOR THE SEAL OF LOCAL GOVERNANCE FOR BARANGAYS. The Panabo City Performance Assessment Team for the Seal of Local Governance for Barangays is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PCPAT. The PCPAT for SGLGB shall perform the following:

- a. Assess the performance of the barangays based on their Data Capture Form (DCF, SGLGB Form 1) and Means of Verification (MOVs);
- b. Sign and certify as to the correctness of the Data Capture Form (DCF, SGLGB Form 1);
- c. Approve and sign the Performance Assessment Form (CPAF, SGLGB Form 8); and
- d. Ensure the completion of the assessment, certification and encoding within the scheduled timeframe.

SECTION 3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PCPAT SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat shall perform the following functions:

- a. Ensure that pilot barangays have submitted all the necessary MOVs needed for the assessment;
- b. Present to the PCPAT, during the assessment meeting, the barangay entries and its MOVs;
- c. Accomplish the DCF, SGLGB Form 1 based on the assessment of the CC PAT;
- d. Facilitate the accomplishment and signing of CC CPAF, SGLGB For 8 by CC PAT;
- e. Submit the signed CC CPAF, SGLGB Form 8 to the Provincial Performance Assessment Team (PPAT);
- f. Encode the assessment data of all barangays in the SGLGB Google Sheet based on the signed DCF, SGLGB Form 1; and
- g. Upload all MOVs of barangay passers based on the signed CC CPAF, SGLGB Form 8.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATION OF THE BARANGAY ASSESSMENT TEAM. The Barangay Assessment Team (BAT) is from a pool of technical experts in a particular performance area who will assist the PCPAT in the SGLGB assessment process. The PCPAT-BAT shall be composed of the following:
