



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 24

**AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROAD AND
REROUTING OF VEHICLES DURING VARIOUS PROGRAMS OF THE 23RD ARAW NG PANABO**

WHEREAS, the City of Panabo will celebrate its 23rd founding anniversary on March 31, 2024;

WHEREAS, in commemoration of the cityhood of Panabo from March 1-23, 2024, various programs and activities will be held, including a motorcade during the opening salvo, and a concert and fireworks display at the Panabo City Hall and Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural and Sports Center (PMTSC) on the Anniversary Program and Mayor's Night;

WHEREAS, Section 21 (c) of Republic Act No. 7160 or otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" explicitly vests upon the Local Chief Executive the power to issue directives pertinent to the duration of temporary closure of national or local road, alley, park or square during an actual emergency, fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural and industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications and waterworks projects;

WHEREAS, to ensure public safety and security of the public and to lighten the traffic during the said activities, the temporary closure of the road and rerouting of affected vehicles is required;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS AND REROUTING OF VEHICLES. Temporary road closures and vehicle rerouting are required to alleviate congestion during the following activities of the City:



SECTION 2. TRAFFIC ASSISTANCE. The City Government of Panabo through the Traffic Management Unit will post traffic advisory/rerouting signs, assist the public/affected vehicles, and manage the traffic during the said activities.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect on the abovementioned dates/time until such road will be reopened to traffic by appropriate authorities.
