EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 247 Series of 2023

AN ORDER CREATING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE NAMING AND RENAMING OF PUBLIC STREETS, PUBLIC SCHOOLS, BUILDINGS, BRIDGES AND SIMILAR PLACES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF PANABO CITY

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" prescribes the general powers and attributes of local government units, embodying therein, among others, the naming of Public Streets;

WHEREAS, the City of Panabo vigorously and continuously implement programs and projects for urban and rural development including construction of roads and bridges among others, thereby there is an increasing need to properly identify and distinguish the different road segments of Panabo City;

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Section 13 (c) to (g) of the Local Government Code of 1991. empowers the Sangguniang of the component cities, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission to name and rename public streets, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares, and other implementation of the established mechanism;

WHEREAS, the guidelines on the naming and renaming of streets was set forth by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) formerly known as the National Historical Institute:

WHEREAS, the City Government of Panabo, through the Sangguniang Panlungsod, enacted City Ordinance No. 04-2023, which established guidelines for the naming and renaming of public streets, public schools, buildings, bridges, and similar public places in the City of Panabo:

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group responsible for executing the functions pertaining to the implementation of the ordinance was created under Section 7 of said legislation;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, City Mayor of Panabo, Province of Davao del Norte, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Technical Working Group (TWG) shall be composed by the following personnel:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The TWG and Secretariat shall perform the following functions:

TWG:

- 1. Conduct an inventory of all roads and streets in the City. The TWG may coordinate with the Task Force on the Inventory of Local Roads on the data of all local roads.
- 2. Determine its metes and bounds.
- 3. Provide assistance to the Committee on Housing, Zoning and Urban Development for the drafting of the Proposed Ordinance on the naming of roads and streets in the City of Panabo.
- 4. Assist in the conduct of public hearings and ocular inspections and/or initiate factual investigations with respect to the proposed name application and submit the recommendation to the Sanggunian.
- 5. Perform such other duties and functions necessary to carry out its functions consistent with the existing national and local guidelines on the naming and renaming of public streets, public schools, buildings, bridges and similar public places.

Secretariat:

1. Facilitate meetings and prepare communications, minutes or highlights of previous meetings and other secretariat functions;

- 2. Keep necessary documents and records of all meetings and activities in relation to the naming of public streets; and
- 3. Perform other secretariat duties and functions as may be assigned by the TWG.

SECTION 3. OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AND FUNDING. All costs pertaining to the operations of the TWG shall be chargeable against available funds and resources of the City, all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY. In the event that any provision in this Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the provisions not hereby affected shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All prior executive issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be deemed repealed.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof.
