EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 304 SERIES OF 2023

AN ORDER AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (CDC), AND ITS EXECUTIVE AND SECTORAL COMMITTEES

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, or the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 provides for the constitution and organization of the Local Development Council in line with the national policy of encouraging local government units to evolve local development plans pursuant to existing laws, executive orders and other related issuances;

WHEREAS, Section 106 of RA 7160 provides that each local government unit shall have a comprehensive multi-sectoral development plan to be initiated by the local development council (LDC) and approved by its Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 111 of RA 7160, the LDC shall create an executive committee to represent it and act in its behalf when it is not in session;

WHEREAS, Section 112 of RA 7160 states that the Local Development Council (LDC) may form sectoral or functional committees to assist them in the performance of their functions and to ensure policy coordination and uniformity in the operational direction;

WHEREAS, Article 62, Rule XIII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the LGC of 1991 mandates LGUs to promote the establishment and operation of Civil Society Organizations to directly involve them in the plans, programs, projects and activities of the local government unit;

WHEREAS, Panabo City Development Council (CDC) with its Executive Committee and Functional/Sectoral Committees was reorganized through Executive Order No. 172, Series of 2023;

WHEREAS, following the 2023 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections, the CDC and its committees must be amended to incorporate the newly elected Barangay Captains and SK Federation President;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL. The City Development Council, its Executive and Sectoral Committees are hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The CDC, CDC Execom and its Sectoral Committees shall perform the following functions:

a. CDC

- 1. Formulate the long-term, medium-term and annual socio-economic development plans and policies;
- 2. Formulate the medium-term and annual public investment programs;
- 3. Appraise and prioritize socio-economic development programs and projects:
- 4. Formulate local investment incentives to promote inflow and direction of private investment capital;
- 5. Coordinate, monitor and evaluate the implementation of development programs and projects;
- 6. Perform such other functions as may be provided for by law or competent authority.

b. CDC Execom

- 1. Ensure that the decision for the Council are faithfully carried out and implemented;
- 2. Act on matters requiring immediate attention or action by the Council;
- 3. Formulate policies, plans and programs, based on the general principles laid down by the Council;
- 4. Act on other matters that may be authorized by the Council.

c. Sectoral Committees

- 1. Assist the CDC in the performance of its functions as stipulated under Section 109 of the LGC.
- 2. Provide the CDC with data and information essential to the formulation of plans, programs and activities;
- 3. Collate and analyze data and conduct studies;
- 4. Conduct public hearings on sectoral planning, projects and activities;
- 5. Monitor and evaluate programs and projects;
- 6. Act on other matters that may be authorized by the Council.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat of the CDC and its functional committees shall be responsible in providing technical support, documentation of proceedings, preparation of reports and such other assistance as may be required in the discharge of its functions. The secretariat shall be composed by the following personnel headed by the City Planning and Development Coordinator:

SECTION 4. MEETINGS AND QUORUM. The CDC shall meet at least once every six (6) months or as often as may be necessary upon the call of the City Mayor.

The presence of the majority, fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of its members and/or authorized representatives shall constitute a quorum and the affirmative vote of the majority of its members and/or the authorized representatives present in a meeting shall be necessary for the council to exercise its powers and functions.

SECTION 5. CSO HONORARIA AND OTHER ALLOWABLE EXPENSES. The CSO engaged in assisting or participating in the CDC's decision-making process, program planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the City's programs and services shall be reimbursed for the applicable cost (honoraria, actual transportation expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses incurred in the performance of duties), subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations provided that CSOs deliver the following:

- a. feedback on programs and projects;
- b. support in pushing for various advocacies; and
- c. assistance in formulating plans, policies and issuances.

SECTION 6. OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AND FUNDING. All costs pertaining to the operations of the Council shall be chargeable against available funds and resources of the City, all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous issuances that are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be deemed superseded and/or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY. Should any part or provision of this order be held invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.
