## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. <u>76</u> Series of 2024

## AN ORDER PARTIALLY CLOSING PORTION OF THE ROAD AT QUEZON ST., BRGY. STO. NIÑO FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, Sec. 21 (c) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", authorizes the local chief executive through written order, may temporarily close both national and local roads during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects;

WHEREAS, Art. 45 (a) (3) of the IRR of RA 7160, states that the temporary closure of road is allowed when public works projects or activities are being undertaken for a period as may be determined necessary for the safety, security, health, or welfare of the public or when such closure is necessary to facilitate completion of the projects or activities;

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) - Davao del Norte District through its contractor, Two Degrees Construction and Supply, will be starting its project 24L00168-Construction of Drainage Structure at Barangay Sto. Niño, Panabo City, Davao del Norte;

**WHEREAS**, the DPWH DDN Sub-District Engineering Office requested for the portion of the two (2) lane road closure on the existing four-lane road along Quezon Street near Somoso Hospital that will be affected by the public works project.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS**, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. PARTIAL CLOSURE OF ROAD.** A portion of the two (2) lane road on the existing four (4) lane road along Quezon St., Barangay Sto. Niño near Somozo Hospital shall be temporarily closed for the road and drainage excavation and construction of a double barrel box culvert project of the DPWH.

**SECTION 2. DURATION.** The project shall start immediately and shall be completed within seventy-nine (79) calendar days.

**SECTION 3. ALTERNATE ROUTE.** All vehicles passing to and from the affected road shall use the remaining two (2) lane road or shall use other alternate routes to avoid due to the occurring civil works.

**SECTION 4. WARNING SIGNS.** The DPWH shall provide traffic advisory/signages and the Traffic Management Unit shall likewise assist the public and concerned vehicles during the said period.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately until the civil works project is completed within seventy-nine (79) calendar days.
