



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 41
Series of 2024

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PANABO CITY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT UNIT

WHEREAS, the traffic problem is one of the perennial concerns of the City of Panabo in view of the increasing population and the growing commercial and industrial districts in the City as a result of its urbanization;

WHEREAS, a number of motorists plying the city roads are in outright disrespect of the traffic laws, rules and regulations despite installations of traffic lights/signs in the City of Panabo;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 31-17, as amended, or otherwise known as the "2017 Revised Traffic Code of Panabo City", provides for the rules and regulations on traffic and prescribing the penalties for its violations;

WHEREAS, in the implementation of the said ordinance, there is a need to complement and reinforce the existing manpower of the Philippine National Police (PNP) in order to respond to the concerns and problems related to traffic congestion as well as in the extensive implementation Panabo City Traffic Code;

WHEREAS, Section 58 of C.O. No. 31-17 created the Traffic Management Unit (TMU), an agency under the Peace and Order and Safety Section of the City Mayor's Office, compositions thereof are designated through Executive Order No. 13, S. 2019;

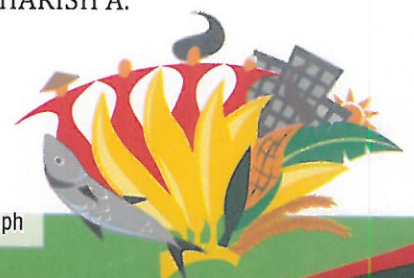
WHEREAS, in order to update the membership and replace those who are no longer affiliated with the unit, the TMU must be reconstituted;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **JOSE E. RELAMPAGOS**, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Panabo City Traffic Management Unit (PCTMU) is hereby reconstituted as follows:

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The PCTMU shall perform the following functions:


1. Assign personnel to direct or control traffic at intersection and other locations requiring such intervention, most especially during rush hours;
2. Execute the enforcement component of any traffic scheme devised or conceived by the PACITRAMCO and approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod;
3. Enforce and implement applicable traffic rules and regulations in this Ordinance and such related ordinances, and laws, subject to such requirements as may be applicable or required by national agencies concerning deputization of enforcers in the enforcement of traffic laws under RA 4136;
4. Apprehend and issue traffic Citation Tickets to drivers found in violation of any provisions of this Ordinance;
5. Report to the Philippine National Police (PNP) Traffic Head on any vehicular accident that occur within the City, and render assistance, when on duty, to the PNP Traffic in responding to such accident, such as but not limited to crowd control, traffic redirection, and first aid assistance;
6. Coordinate with the Philippine National Police (PNP) and other affiliating agencies to harmonize personnel deployment and field operations within the City;
7. Initiate the removal of vehicles obstructing traffic;
8. Suggest changes in any traffic scheme, including provision of traffic signals;
9. Hear and receive complaints relating to the implementation of this Ordinance and thereafter submit such complaints to the PACITRAMCO;
10. Regularly enhance and develop the knowledge, skills, and attitude amongst the members, for better, efficient dealings with the drivers, pedestrians and others;
11. Formulate and implement a local traffic education and road safety program; and
12. Execute such other duties functions as specified in this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REPORTING. The PCTMU shall be under the Office of the City Mayor and shall regularly report on the status of the implementation of the traffic code and the traffic management in the City of Panabo to the City Mayor.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders and directives inconsistent with any provision found herein are hereby repealed, superseded, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.
